- Who:** All students grades K-12 (see notes below regarding prize eligibility)
- When:** **Saturday, January 23, 2016.** Check in from 8 to 8:30 am.  
Awards ceremony after fifth round, estimated between 2 and 3 pm.
- Where:** **LakeView Technology Academy, 9449 - 88th Ave, Pleasant Prairie, WI 53158**  
Easy access from I-94. Located on County H just north of Highway 165
- How:** All students will play 5 games of chess in a Swiss-style (modified round robin) format. There is no elimination, and each student will play each round. All are welcome, beginners to advanced players. Games will be Game/25 with 5 second delay.

## **Individual Prizes in each section (First, Second, Third)**

**K-2 Unrated:** Chess set with quiver, chess set with bag, magnetic chess set

**K-5 Unrated:** Digital chess clock, chess set with case, chess set with quiver

**K-8 Unrated:** Digital chess clock, chess set with case, silicone chess pieces

**K-12 Unrated:** \$100 scholarship, digital chess clock, heavy chess set with case

Participation medals/prizes for all. Sportsmanship prizes in each section.

**Note:** Individual prizes are limited to players who attend school in the following counties: Kenosha, Racine, Walworth and Lake. Home school students in those counties are eligible. Bring documentation of school address to check in (report card or registration).

**Team Trophies:** Two or more students in the same section from the same school will automatically be considered a "team." The team score is the sum of the top 4 individual scores.  
3 Team Trophies in K2 K5 (combined), 3 team trophies for K8/K12 sections together

**Cost:** **Free** with early email registration by January 20<sup>th</sup> at 11 pm  
Or \$5 per student if registering at the door (payable by cash or check to KCA)
